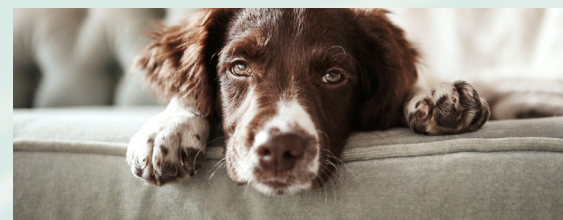

The Dental Cleaning and Spay/Neuters in our **Platinum Plan** includes:

- Daytime Hospitalization
- IV Catheter and Fluids
- General Anesthesia
- Vital Signs Monitoring
- Full Mouth Digital X-Rays (Dental Procedures)
- Pre and Post Operative Pain Management (Spay/Neuter)
- Surgical Laser (Spay/Neuter) – reduces swelling, bleeding and pain
- Therapy Laser (Spay/Neuter) – reduces inflammation, pain and speeds healing

Our Comprehensive Semi-Annual Exams include:

- Weight Assessment
- Coat and Skin Evaluation
- Ophthalmic and Otoscopic Exam
- Heart, Lung, Abdominal Evaluation
- Oral, Neurological, Musculoskeletal, and Urogenital Evaluations

Our Comprehensive 23 Chemistry Blood Panels for Adult Dogs include Protein, Cholesterol, Triglycerides, Electrolyte, Kidney, Diabetes, and Liver Screenings. Puppies receive Pre-Anesthetic Blood Screenings which include Clotting Evaluation.
